Every year at Thanksgiving we sit around a table with far too much food and someone inevitably asks the question, "What are you thankful for?" This reminds me of a conversation I've been having to have with my kids lately. My kids are getting old enough to start learning how to handle money. So, we've instituted the chore chart. At their ages it's pretty basic, do a chore get a quarter (or nickel if dad's feeling particularly cheap). It's become our routine to only have pay day once a week, so that they get paid for all their hard work through the week and I only have to mess with it once a week. We are trying to teach them to be generous and to save for big expenses and things of that nature so every payday I sit down and explain that they can't simply put all their money in their savings or their spending jars. The part they struggle with most, however, is the giving jar. Week after week I find myself explaining that they need to give some of their money back to God. In the Old Testament the Israelites were asked to give ten percent, but in the New Testament the only guide we are given is that all of it is God's. Right now, my kids give because their dad makes them, but the reason I make them is because I want them to learn something. It's not going to make a difference in the church finances if my kid gives his 20 cents this week or not, but it will make a difference if my kid learns to be thankful in a way that expresses itself tangibly; if he/she learns to have an attitude of gratitude. Yes, I want my kid to be thankful for this money, but more importantly I want him to be thankful to God for this blessing.

The Psalms have more to say about giving thanks than any other book in the Bible, by far. Of the 133 times the bible uses the words "thanks" or "thanksgiving" 46 of them are in the Psalms. The next book that uses this word the most is Nehemiah with only eight usages. The psalms make it clear, thankfulness is not a thing to be done half-heartedly. "I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds"- Ps. 9:1. "I give thanks to you, O Lord my God, with my whole heart, and I will glorify your name forever"- Ps. 86:12. "I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation"- Ps. 111:1. We are told to give thanks aloud or in song 11 different times, and we are to do this so that others can hear. We are told to give thanks among the people (105:1), in the company of the upright (111:1), among the throng (109:30), among the nations (57:9; 108:3). Basically, we are to give thanks with all that we are so that others can hear it. However, the reason others are supposed to hear it is because of who is receiving this thanks.

11 different times the psalmist gives thanks to "the name". God is the one who is worthy of our thanks. He is the only one to whom thanks is given throughout the Psalms. Partially because he is good (used in 8 different places) and partially because of what he's done (4 different places). In fact, the phrase, "give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever" is used almost verbatim in six different places in the Psalms. It is because of his righteousness, goodness, and love that we give him thanks.

So, this month as we sit around a table with friends and family and far too much food and we talk about what we are thankful for, don't forget who we're thankful to. We are thankful to the one who loved us enough to send his son to die for us. We are thankful to the one who's love endures forever, who is righteous and holy, and who is the giver of all good things (James 1:17). Maybe this year you might find a Psalm to read with your family (Psalm 117 or 118 are good ones) to remind everyone to "give thanks to the LORD for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever!"
